BRING

- Prescription (controlled and non-controlled)
- Over-the-counter medications
- Ointments, patches, non-aerosol sprays, and inhalers
- Creams, vials, and pet medications

DO NOT BRING

- Illegal drugs, needles/sharps, or aerosol cans
- Bio-hazardous materials (anything containing bodily liquid or blood)
- Mercury thermometers or personal care products (shampoo, soaps, lotions, sunscreen, etc.)
- Household hazardous waste (paint, pesticides, oil, gas)

April 27th is a National Drug Take Back Day. The Forest County Sheriff's Department & the Community Coalition of Forest County are encouraging community members to clean out any unwanted/unused medications from their cabinets and bring them to any of the locations listed below.
